PROS

SELECTION

ENTRY LEVEL

LAMINATE



FINISH TYPE: Semi Smooth, Printed Surface

APPEARANCE: Mimics stone, timber, or solid colours with a clean finish

DURABILITY: Stain resistant, but can be damaged by high heat

AFFORDABLE

PORCELAIN



FINISH TYPE: Ultra-Smooth, Glazed, Textured

APPEARANCE: Sleek stone-look surface, often with realistic veining

DURABILITY: Extremely hard-wearing, heatproof and non-porous, prone to chipping if not sealed

TIMBER/HARDWOOD



FINISH TYPE: Natural Grain, Oiled or Sealed

APPEARANCE: Warm and organic with unique grain patterns and colour variation

DURABILITY: Can scratch or stain but is repairable through sanding and refinishing

CONCRETE



FINISH TYPE: Textured or Polished

APPEARANCE: Raw, industrial look with natural pits and colour variation

BENEFITS: Strong and heat resistant, but can stain or crack if not properly sealed and maintained

QUARTZ



FINISH TYPE: Smooth, Engineered Stone

APPEARANCE: Consistent patterns and colours with a sleek, modern look

BENEFITS: Highly durable, non-porous, stain and scratch resistant with minimal maintenance

GRANITE



FINISH TYPE: Polished, Natural

APPEARANCE: Natural stone with unique speckled patterns and rich colour variation

BENEFITS: Extremely hard and heat resistant, low maintenance when sealed properly

APPEARANCE: Elegant, natural veining with soft, light-toned colour palettes

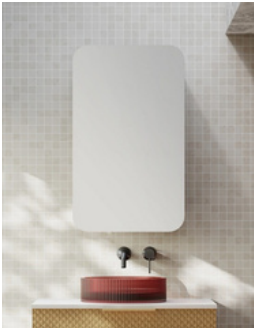

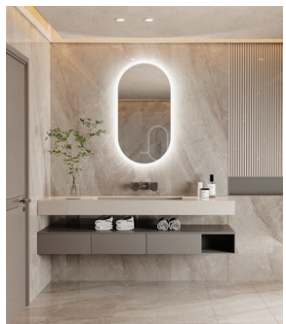

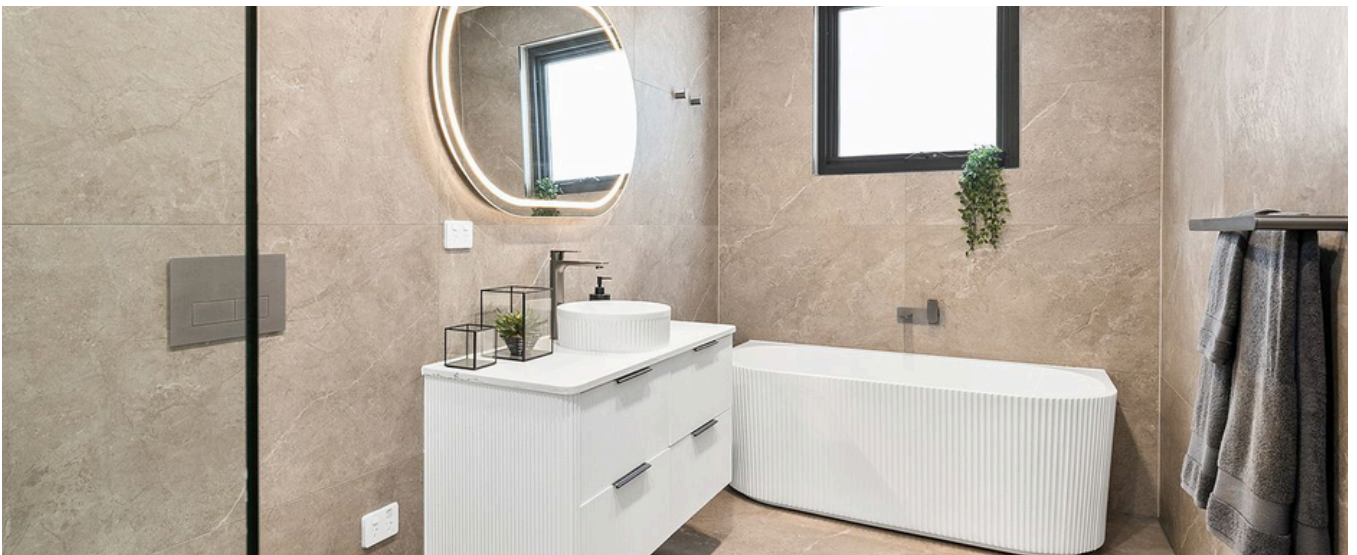
